### CONTEXT

The IHU Strasbourg is a multidisciplinary institute dedicated to the creation and dissemination of innovative image-guided therapies and minimally invasive precision surgery -enhanced by virtual reality, robotics and artificial intelligence-, and its integration into an innovative care model using e-health tools and prioritizing early diagnosis, outpatient surgery or reduced hospital stay and early rehabilitation after surgery. The IHU Strasbourg participates in translational research and development projects intended both for academic and education outcomes but also for transfer to industry or creation of start-up companies.

In a unique, state-of-the-art work environment, the IHU Innovation team works hand in hand with researchers and clinicians to implement their innovative projects. It puts in place all the resources needed to guarantee the successful completion and future exploitation of these projects. ### MISSIONS

- Work closely with researchers and clinicians, particularly in setting up preclinical and clinical trials
- Ensure the operational and budgetary management of a portfolio of 4-5 collaborative and multidisciplinary projects and ensure efficient reporting, using project management software tools
- Coordinate R&D partnerships with academics, industry and service providers
- Participate in the implementation of a quality management approach and in the follow-up of regulatory steps
- Follow up on the valorisation activities, in close collaboration with a Tech transfer officer (validation of medical needs, intellectual property strategy, etc.)
- Support research teams in writing translational research and innovation projects grants applications
- Participate in the internal missions of the Innovation team, being responsible of one administrative task to be defined.
- Participate in the organization of the Institute's events on research and innovation themes

- Minimum of 5 years of higher education (engineering school, computer science, regulatory, health).
- You have at least two years of experience in managing innovative multidisciplinary projects in one of the following fields: research, engineering, computer development or artificial intelligence.
- Experience in a medical device environment is preferred. Experience in a start-up or working with industrial partners or customers will be appreciated.
